



# Supporting Youth Mental Health Care in New Brunswick

Medavie funding ACCESS Open Minds New Brunswick in partnership with New Brunswick Health Research Foundation

**Moncton, NB** – ACCESS Open Minds New Brunswick (ACCESS OM NB) is working to ensure New Brunswick youth experiencing mental health challenges have access to the right care, at the right time, in the right place. Medavie is providing \$360,000 over three years in support of ACCESS OM NB operations and activities. These funds are in addition to the New Brunswick Health Research Foundation (NBHRF) investment in March 2015 of \$1.7 million over seven years. This funding brings Medavie's support of mental health initiatives in New Brunswick to over \$1.5 million to-date.

ACCESS OM NB is the only provincial demonstration site of the 14 ACCESS Open Minds sites across Canada. Led by Primary Investigator Dr. Jimmy Bourque of the Université de Moncton, ACCESS OM NB has taken a community approach to youth mental health system transformation, partnering with Centre de Bénévolat de la Péninsule Acadienne, P.E.E.R Saint John, and the Elsipogtog First Nation community. ACCESS Open Minds is a national research and evaluation project co-funded by the Canadian Institutes for Health Research (CIHR) and the Graham Boeckh Foundation (GBF) that aims to transform the way youth aged 11 to 25 access and use mental health services in Canada.

This funding was announced at the Université de Moncton this morning, with partner representatives and stakeholders in attendance.

# **Quick Facts**

- The rate of hospitalizations and emergency department visits by young Canadians for mental disorders increased by 45 per cent from 2006 to 2014, with youth aged 15 to 17 having the highest volume of visits and hospitalizations.<sup>1</sup> New Brunswick's rate of youth hospitalization due to mental health issues is twice the Canadian average.<sup>2</sup>
- Over 75% of mental health problems first appear between early adolescence and young adulthood.<sup>3</sup>

• Early intervention and treatment allow youth to develop positive mental health strategies leading to improved personal achievement, positive contribution to society, and significant cost savings to the health care, justice and social service systems.
